I have worked hard with the whole school team to improve the school year on year and am proud to have led them through many exciting developments including two "Good" Ofsted inspections. The experiences that they give your amazing children every day is exceptional – it's a very special school and I will take with me so many happy memories, stories and anecdotes that I will treasure for the rest of my life. Thank you to all parents past and present who have supported the school and myself – it makes all the difference.

I am off school following surgery currently, but hope to be back in a few weeks' time to enjoy the end of the school year and be able to say my goodbyes. In the meantime, Rishi Makwana, Chair of Governors, the governing body and DCC will be looking ahead and setting the wheels in motion to appoint a new Headteacher. This is an exciting time for the school as governors seek an inspirational and experienced leader who will lead the school into future successes.
