Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our curriculum work in science, Eagles, Ospreys and Sparrowhawks classes are going on a school trip to Thinktank, Birmingham Science Museum, on Tuesday 12th February.

During our trip, children will be touring the galleries, visiting the Planetarium and taking part in a workshop on habitats. These activities link to our spring term science topics which are 'Living Things and Their Habitats' and 'Earth and Space'. The trip will provide the children with a valuable and fun curriculum enrichment opportunity, and the chance to develop their skills and knowledge in these core subject areas.

The coaches will leave school at 8:45am promptly, to get to Thinktank by 9:45, in time to start our first activity there. Please could you make sure that your child is in school by <u>8:30 prompt</u> for registration on this day. They will need to bring with them a packed lunch, including a drink, either in a disposable bag or a <u>light</u> bag that they don't mind carrying with them all day. Please ensure that their bag has their name on it. If your child has free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them by the school kitchen, *if you request this on the slip below*.

Your child will not need spending money as we will not be visiting the gift shop, to avoid losing valuable learning time by queueing up! Coaches will leave Birmingham at approximately 2:15pm, to get back to school in time for home time. We will update you via the eschools app in the event of any delay caused by traffic.

So that we can fund the trip, a voluntary contribution of £12.50 per child is required. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium finding, the voluntary contribution is £6.25. This includes £4.50 entrance to the museum and £4 for EACH workshop (£8). The PTFA have kindly agreed to fund the coaches for the trip.

Please could you complete the attached form and return it to your child's class teacher by Friday 18th January. We will use the 'parental consent for an offsite visit' forms which are held in the school office for this trip, please ensure that this is updated with current medical and contact information if needs be at the school office.
