Can you make a volcano at home? Look on the internet for a recipe that you can make out of things you could find at home. Ask permission!! Record your volcano erupting!!	5	
Write a diary extract as though you were living at the bottom of a volcano when it erupted. Remember to write about how you feel as well as the sounds, sights and smells.	5	
Research a recent volcano eruption (see http://volcano.si.edu/reports_weekly.cfm#vn_390090) and write a newspaper report about it.	5	
Write a non-chronological (fact file) report about what happens when a volcano erupts under the sea.	5

Design a game that involves using your knowledge of working out fractions of shapes, numbers or measurements.	5	
Choose a 3 or 4 digit number. How many different ways can you make the number using all four of the different number operations, + x - ÷ Write at least 20.	3	
Make a poster explaining how to teach other children about short multiplication.	2

Create a poster explaining a spelling rule, e.g. adding the prefix 'un' to a root word.	2	
Produce a poster to promote Anti-Bullying Week in school.	3	
Use wordle to create a poster of adverbs, e.g. quickly etc. http://www.wordle.net/create Remember an adverbs explains how you do something.	2	
Harry Potter is book for boys. Do you agree with this statement? Can you persuade your teacher to agree with your point of view? This can be a piece of writing or recorded video.	3	
Write a discussion text about a topic of your choice. Remember; your introduction must explain the topic and why it is important, you must include an equal number of 'for' and 'against' arguments and you must show your point of view at the end.	5
