Maths and English



English

Maths

Other subjects

Our topic work and science work this term will be largely based around water. We will be looking at the water cycle and comparing different involves studying the movement of the sun German we will learn and how this affects

us, and also how this affects night and day. Our RE will consider the life of Buddha. In PSHCE our theme is expressing faith through art. In PE we will be developing states of matter. This our cardio-agility, reaction and response. In about the local area.

Computing will explore data handling. In Art we will be making a toy. In music our topic is reflect, rewind and replay.

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Rapid Number Recall

Rapid number recall is based on the belief that if children have rapid recall of key facts in maths, they will find all other areas of the maths curriculum much easier. For example, when being asked to find out the fraction of an amount, if they have good understanding of their multiplication facts, they will find this much easier.

The program is based on a series of steps, and within each step there are several objectives. Your child's teacher will initially tell your child where they will start and then they will work through the steps in order.

You will find the step that your child is working on, and the target within that step, in their reading journal, along with ideas about how you can help them to achieve this target. Children will also have time to practice these in school, but obviously the more help they get the quicker they will achieve!

Each target has a 24 question quiz that children will be asked to complete daily. When they can get 100% three times, children will move on to the next target. The progress your child is making will be recorded in their reading diaries so that you can share their successes with them.

Cadbury World


We are very excited about our school trip tomorrow to Cadbury world.


Workshops are held in classrooms and showcases may be in classrooms or in the hall/outside, depending on the theme of the showcase. Times will be confirmed nearer the time.
