Use different materials to make a collage of a starry night. What can you see?	2	
Make a poster to explain why it is dangerous to look at the sun. Explain how we protect our eyes.	5

Visit your local church and write a fact file about it. When was the church built? How old is the church? What special celebrations do they have? Include a photo if you can.	5
