<u>Humanities</u>		
Research and write a report about Mount Vesuvius in Pompeii.	5	
Look at a world map. List all of the oceans. Which sea covers the biggest area and where is it?	2	
Draw and label a picture of a famous volcano. Include the different layers and write about why it is famous.	5	
<u>Science</u>		
Keep a shadow diary. Measure your shadow at different times of the day and record in a table. Why does the length of your shadow change according to the time of day?	3	
Write a poem about a rainbow. Consider what you have learned in your science lesson about the colours of the rainbow! Make sure you include some of the features of poetry you have learned in class.	5	
Look at the BBC Schools Science website. Do some of the activities about 'How We See Things'. Write a report about what you learn.	3	
<u>Citizenship</u>		
Design a circle time game that we can play in our citizenship lesson. Write a set of instructions for it. We will play them in class!	3	
Draw a poster about how to stay safe online. Think about the SMART rules!	2	
<u>RE</u>		
Design a poster about someone you look up to or are inspired by. What qualities do they have that inspire you?	2

Write a quiz about one of the spelling rules that you have learned about this term. Make sure you write a paragraph first to explain the rule clearly and give examples, to help the person doing the quiz!	3	
Find a poem that contains the following poetic features: metaphor, simile, personification, alliteration, onomatopoeia, hyperbole. Copy or glue it into your book. Highlight the features and annotate the poem.	5	
Research and read a classic poem from our literary heritage. Write about what you thought about it. Did you like it? Why/why not?	2	
<u>Maths</u>		
Logon to Interactive Resources (logon EPS Pupil, password EPS Pupil). Play some of the maths games saved in the Eagles and Ospreys folder. Write down which ones you played and how they helped you in maths!	2	
Research temperatures of countries around the world. Plot them on to a line graph. Make sure you include some positive and some negative numbers.	5	
<u>D&T - Textiles</u>		
Design and make a Christmas decoration using fabric and a needle and thread or fabric glue. Ask an adult to help you! Bring it in to show your teacher – perhaps we can add it to the classroom Christmas tree!	5
